Inspect the tool after each use, and keep it in good working order. Replace or repair worn or defective equipment immediately. Keep the tool clean and store it in a dry place. Never use a power tool around flammable liquids such as gasoline or solvents. Keep the work area clean of sawdust, shavings or anything else that could pose a fire hazard.


