Episkopi is the current location of Headquarters British Forces Cyprus. Commander British Forces Cyprus (CBF) and Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas is a two-star appointment, alternating every three years between a British Army major-general and a Royal Air Force air vice-marshal.

Telsim Vodafone: Telsim Vodafone also offers a diverse array of packages, making it a strong competitor in the market. Currently, 4G technology is not available in Northern Cyprus, meaning mobile internet speeds typically range between 3-7 Mbps with a ping of 20-30ms.

How many British forces sites are there in Cyprus?

British Forces Cyprus retains the right to use 13 retained sites with the remaining 27 having been returned to Cyprus after the Ministry of Defence no longer required them. The most recent sites to be returned were the Berengaria Married Quarters in 2011, because they had become obsolete and the firing range on the Akamas peninsula in 1999-2001.

What is the oldest British military base in Cyprus?

Troodos Station is the oldest remaining British military base in Cyprus, dating from 1878. Initially it was used as a cool summer field hospital for troops from the Egyptian Campaign. British Army and Government officials also used it as a summer retreat.


